

## **DISCUSSION BUBBLES**

These discussion starters can be handed out to small groups to aid group discussion.

They are also useful to have cut and laminated in order pull out during ICT lessons to have a quick discussion. Always keeping internet safety at the forefront of children and young people's minds whenever they access the internet.

There is also a page of blank speech bubbles which can be edited to suit your cohort. You could challenge the students to write their own to share with each other.

After any discussion it is always a good idea to remind students that tootoot is always there for them day or night for any concerns, internet based or otherwise.
